



DIRECTIONS TO THE GROUNDS

Highland Recreation Area, Barn Course, is located on Cooley Lake Rd. between Duck Lake Rd. and Beaumont Rd. Cooley Lake Rd. is south of Livingston Rd., running East/West between Milford Rd. & Duck Lake Rd. There will be no horses, it is a walking course.



PARKING AT THE GROUNDS

The DNR requires all vehicles to have a 'parking sticker' to park on the grounds, regardless if you are camping or not.

Non-MI residents or MI residents who do not have the required Recreation Passport must complete the self-registration form and submit the appropriate fees. The forms will be located on the green stand by the guard rail.

The DNR will be actively checking for compliance with this state requirement.

In accordance with the AKC guidelines for pointing breed hunt tests (August 2007) tracking collars will be permitted in all levels of testing. Special Training Collars are prohibited.
